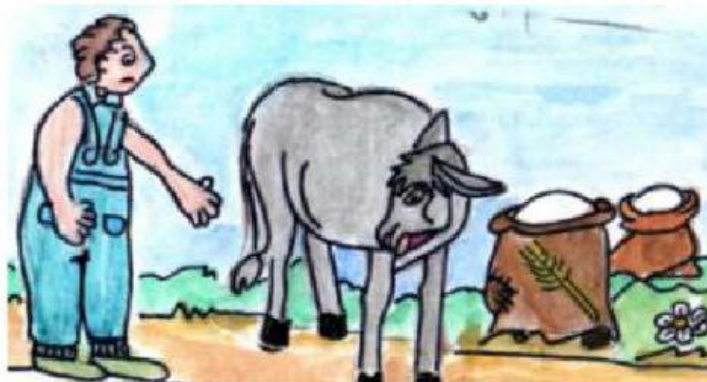


Step 1: listen and read.

🔊 On the way to Bremen, he meets a dog that can't go hunting and has moved away from his home. The donkey invites him to go to Bremen.



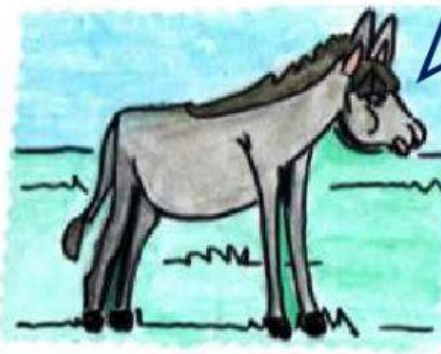
🔊 The donkey can play the lute and the dog the eardrums.

))) Then, the donkey says to join him and go to Bremen to sing and play.

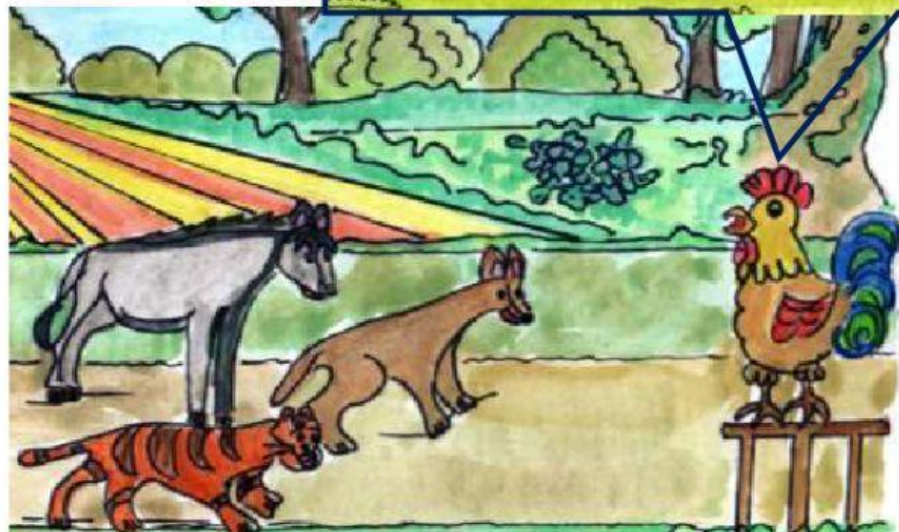
The cat agrees and leaves with them.



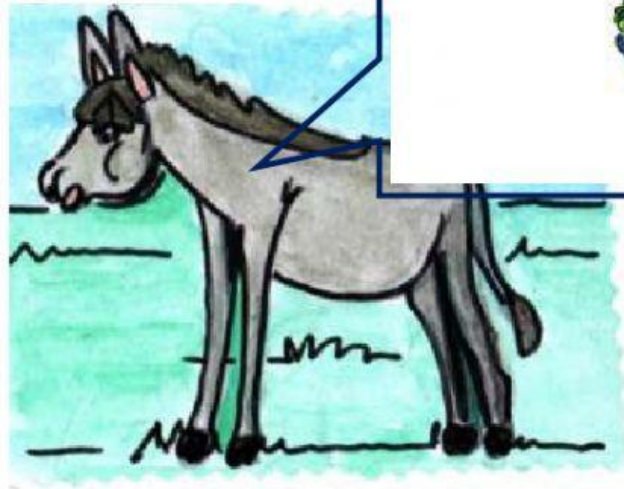
Leave with us. We are going to Bremen for sing and song!



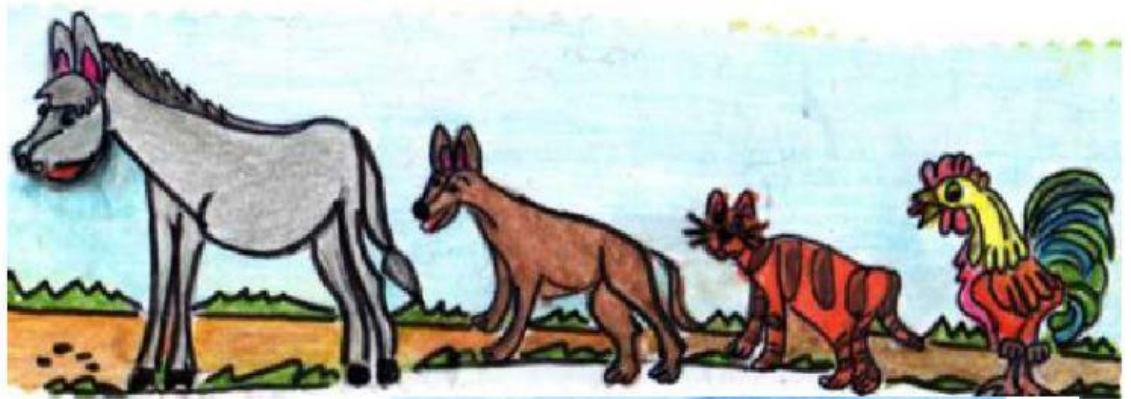

Bremen.

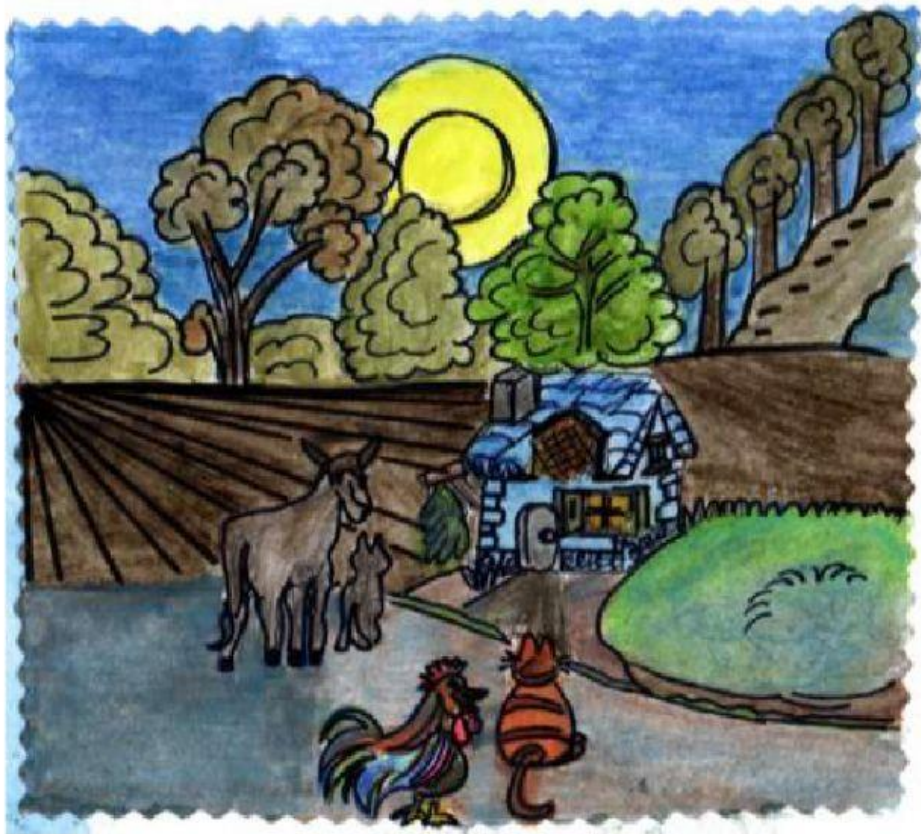


))) At night,

))) The four animals, very hungry, decide to get the brigands out of the house and to eat their leftovers.

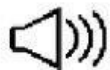


))) The bandits get scared of that big noise and think there is a ghost in the house! Then they run into the woods terrified.





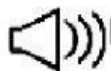
The donkey, the dog, the cat, and the cock, came into the house, and eat everything they find.



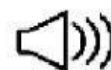

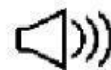
As they are all very exhausted, they fall asleep immediately.

When the bandit tries to escape, he finds the

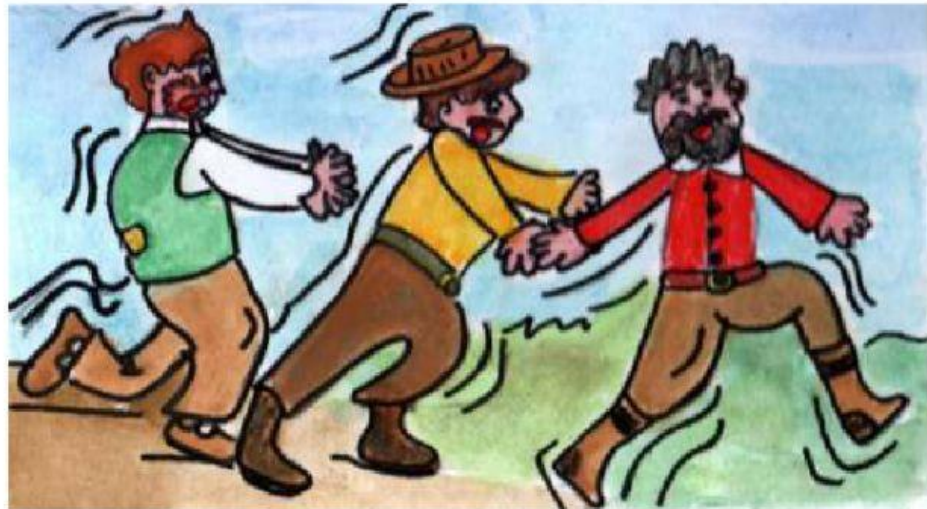
dog behind the door that bites his leg. He then crosses the courtyard but
