- TYPE 2 - **IMAGINARY SITUATIONS IN THE PRESENT** - **NOT TRUE OR NOT LIKELY TO HAPPEN.**

- TYPE 3 - **IMAGINARY SITUATIONS IN THE PAST** - **IMPOSSIBLE TO HAPPEN.**
