Are drones really useful?



Drones were first used by the military in areas that were dangerous or difficult for normal pilots. They were used as an 'eye-in-the-sky' to send images of war zones. Now they are popular in everyday life and many people have one.

But are drones a good thing? It is difficult to enjoy the peace and quiet of the mountains or beautiful national parks when people are flying their noisy drones in **these** areas. They are dangerous if they are flown near airports. People also worry that drones are secretly taking photos of them and don't want these photos to appear on social media.

However, drones take fantastic photos from the air and show us views that we have never seen before. It is a different way of sightseeing. People now want to show and share their holidays and weddings more creatively by taking drone photos and videos of themselves! Travel companies are keen on drone images too for their websites and images from the air also give important information to scientists. They show how changes to the climate affect forests and farms, rivers and deserts.

Many people think that 'drone-diving' will soon be the next extreme sport. A drone will take you up into the air and then let you parachute back to earth. This year, a football for a Portuguese football match was flown into the stadium by a man standing on and flying a drone! Will drone-surfing be the next big hobby?

Apart from free-time activities, there are already plans to use drones for transport. Drones will fly in to pick up food, shopping and packages from a special drone center and transport them quickly and easily to people who live and work in the cities. They will also drop medicines and food by parachute in areas that are affected by disasters like earthquakes and hurricanes.

Drones offer many possibilities. But if drones are going to be part of our future, like robots and artificial intelligence, we will need rules to explain clearly how to use them.

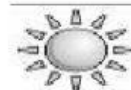
