Adjective + noun

noun + be + adjective	adjective + noun
These headphones are great. This painting is beautiful. My phone is old.	These are great headphones . It's a beautiful painting . I have an old phone .

Word order

I have a new phone. ✓ I have a phone new. X

TIP Use **a/an** before adjective + single noun

*It's **a** beautiful painting. I have **an** old phone.*
