

Famous British dishes- part 2

dish	Name and Ingredients
	It is called Sunday roast with Yorkshire pudding. It is composed of roasted meat (chicken , beef, pork or lamb), vegetables, roast potatoes, Yorkshire puddings and plenty of gravy.
	The Cornish pasty is filled with sliced or diced potato, swede, onion and diced or minced beef in pastry which has a “D” shape.
	The toad in the hole is a dish with sausages sticking out of Yorkshire pudding batter, usually served with vegetables and onion gravy.
	It is called Bubble and squeak. It consists of frying leftover vegetables (carrots, broccoli, swede with mashed or fried potato) and served with cold leftover meat.
