Grammar Review

Past Simple and Past Continuous

- We use the **past continuous** to talk about an action that was in progress in the past. We use the **past simple** to talk about an action that finished in the past.
e.g. *The burglar **was climbing** through the window when the police officer **saw** him.*
- We often use the **past continuous** and the **past simple** together. We connect the actions with **when** and **while**.
e.g. *The thief took my bag **while** I was reading a magazine.*

- ✓ To create Past Continuous, we need "BE + VERB – ING"
- ✓ But remember: It's **PAST** so the verb to be must go in PAST: **WAS + WERE**

When - While

Generally, both "when" and "while" conjunctions are related to past tense. "**While**" connects two actions happening at the same time, and "**when**" interrupts an action continuously happening in the past with another action in the past.

Examples:

- a. Susana was reading a magazine. I was watching TV.
- *Susana was reading a magazine **WHILE** I was watching TV.*

- b. Pedro and I were playing videogames. Felipe knocked the door.
 - Pedro and I were playing videogames **WHEN** Felipe knocked the door.

"While" means:	a. De repente / De pronto	b. Mientras que / Mientras
"When" means:	a. Cuando	b. Dónde
