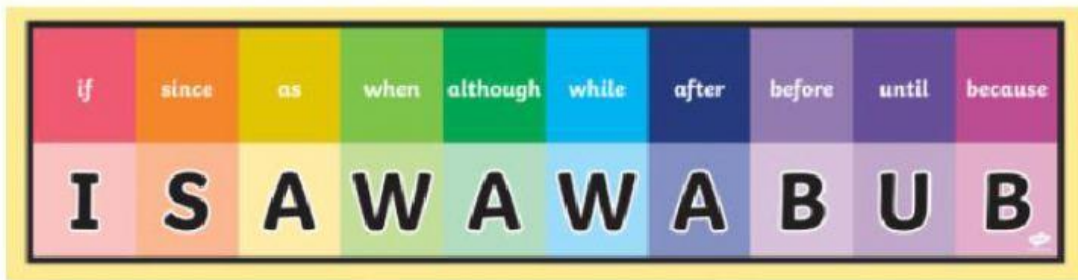


Complex Sentences
