George Clooney is an American actor who gained wide recognition in his role as Dr. Douglas on the long-running medical drama ER from 1994 to 1999, for which he received two Emmy Award nominations. While he was working on ER, he began attracting a variety of leading roles in films, including Batman & Robin in 1997. He is the only person in Academy Award history to be nominated for Oscars in six different categories.



Throughout his career, Clooney has been heralded for his political activism and humanitarian work. He has served as one of the United Nation Messengers of Peace since 2008. He organized the Hope for Haiti telethon, to raise money for the victims of the 2010 earthquake. In March of 2012, Clooney was arrested for civil disobedience while protesting at the Sudanese embassy in Washington, D.C.

However, last year his motorbike started to make strange noises and it broke down in a small village. Luckily, he found an old beekeeper who told him he could mend it for him, but it would take a while.
