




A: What's on TV?

 B: No, I don't.



A: What's on channel 3?
 B: Football. Do you like football?
 A: Yes, I do.

Presentation

Affirmative

I/You We/You/They like tennis.

Negative

I/You We/You/They don't like football.

TIP *don't = do not*

Yes/No questions

Do I/you we/you/they like basketball.
 swimming.

Short answers

Yes,	I/you/we/you/they	do.
No,	I/you we/you/they	don't.
