Adjective	Comparative Form	Superlative Form
good bad far fun boring famous ill	<b>better</b> <b>worse</b> <b>farther</b> <b>more fun</b> <b>more boring</b> <b>more famous</b> <b>worse</b>	<b>best</b> <b>worst</b> <b>farthest</b> <b>most fun</b> <b>most boring</b> <b>most famous</b> <b>worst</b>
