

Present Perfect Tense

FORM: have / has + past participle

Affirmative: I **have seen** the film before.
She **has seen** the film before.

Interrogative: **Have you seen** the film before?
Has she seen the film before?

Negative: They **haven't seen** the film before.
He **hasn't seen** the film before.

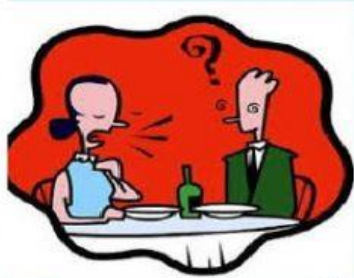
