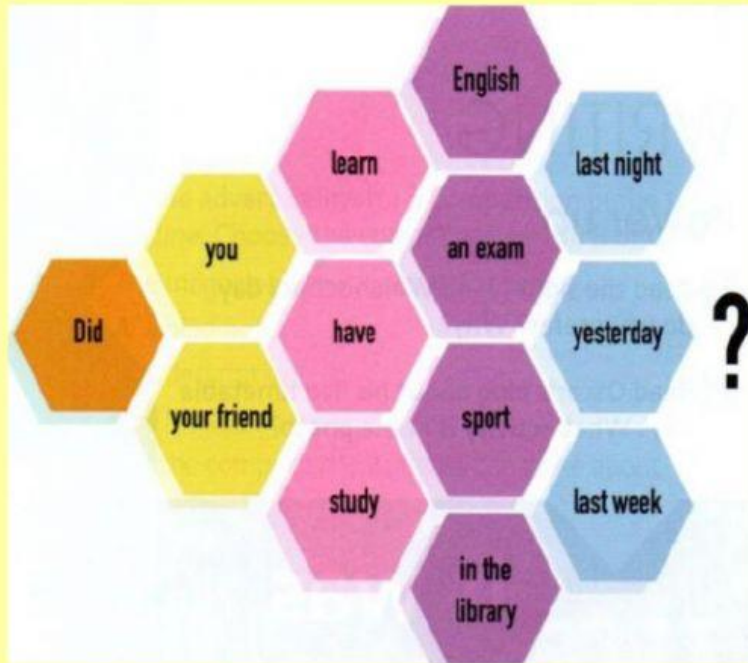


## Speaking
