

PRESENT PERFECT WITH YET (negative sentences)

MAKE SENTENCES USING THE WORDS IN PARENTHESES. REMEMBER THAT ALL SENTENCES ARE NEGATIVE.

EXAMPLE: (I – see – Gabriel – yet) – I HAVEN'T SEEN GABRIEL YET.
