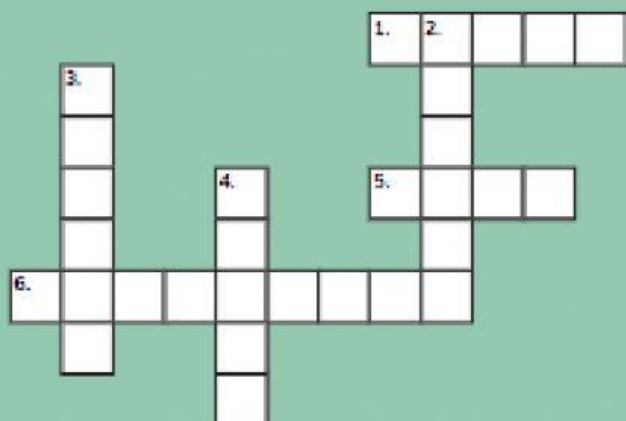
Read the paragraph while you listen to me read it in the video. Then select the correct answer.
