



- A: This is my favourite food market. I love it here.

- B: Simone loves them. Potatoes are her favourite.
- A: OK. What about Marco?
- B: He likes fruit.
- A: I have these bananas. Anything else?

### Presentation

Subject pronoun	Object pronoun
I	me
you	you
he	him
she	her
it	it
we	us
you	you
they	them
Peter likes	me you him her it us you them

**TIP** Subject pronouns are **before** the verb:  
*I/you/he/she/it/we/you/they like(s) Peter.*

Object pronouns are **after** the verb:  
*Peter likes me/you/him/her/it/us/you/them.*
