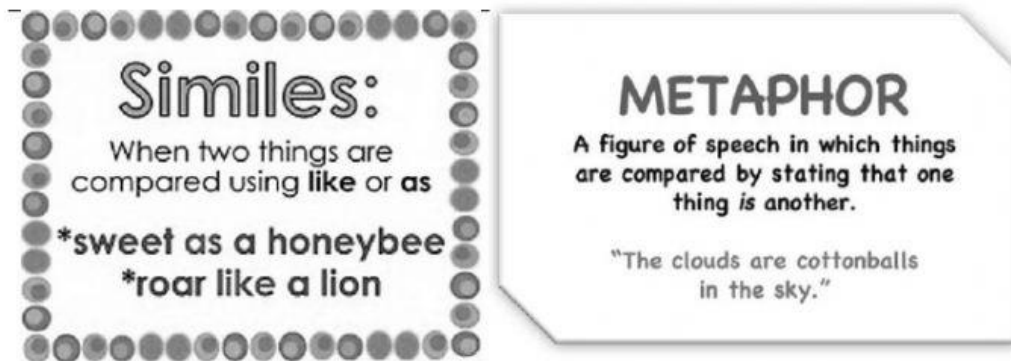


FICTION: Similes & Metaphors
