

# Simple Past Tense (Questions)

Verb-to-be:	1. <b>Was</b> he unwell this morning? Yes, he <u>was</u> . / No, he <u>wasn't</u> . 2. <b>Were</b> they friends in the past? Yes, they <u>were</u> . / No they <u>weren't</u> .
Action verbs:	3. <b>Did</b> you <u>go</u> to the mall yesterday? Yes, I <u>did</u> . / Yes, I <u>went</u> to the mall yesterday. No, I <u>didn't</u> . / No, I <u>didn't go</u> to the mall yesterday.
