

SINGULAR AND PLURAL NOUNS.

What's this?

o It's a book.
 (It IS a book.)



o It's an umbrella.
 (It IS an umbrella.)



A + singular noun

o We use **A** with singular nouns beginning with a consonant sound.

Examples: a book
 a magazine
 a toothbrush

An + singular noun

o We use **AN** with singular nouns beginning with a vowel sound.

Examples: an umbrella
 an iPad
 an apple
