Decimals Exercise 1A

A decimal is a numeral in the decimal number system.

- A decimal can represent a fraction.

For example: $\frac{3}{10}$ as a decimal is 0.3


- A decimal can represent a whole number and a fraction.

For example: $4\frac{3}{10}$ as a decimal is 4.3

0.3 and 4.3 are both decimals.

Look at the number 925.36

Can you see the symmetrical pattern to the place names around the ones place?



The decimal point separates the whole numbers from the fractional numbers.

$$0.3 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \quad 0.03 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$1.5 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \quad 1.05 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$34.6 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \quad 34.06 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$30.1 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \quad 3.01 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$5.60 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \quad 6.40 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$
