HARRODS

"Harrods" is perhaps the most famous department store in London. It attracts shoppers from all over the world. Millions of customers go through its doors every day. It's the largest department store in Europe with a space of over a million square feet and 330 different departments on seven floors.

The shop's motto is "All Things for All People, Everywhere." Perhaps, it's the best way to describe what you can buy at "Harrods". Products on offer include clothes, electronics, pets, toys, food and drink, furniture, sports equipment, household goods and much more. And in case you are tired you can enjoy a meal in one of the 27 restaurants and bars, which serve everything from tea to haute cuisine (cooking of a very high standard).

More than 5,000 people work at "Harrods" ("Harrods" staff). It also has 8 doormen, known as "Green Men" because of the uniform they wear. They open the door for you when you come and leave the store, they can call a taxi for you or help with directions. All other staff wear black or gray formal clothes.

You should also watch what you wear when you are visiting "Harrods", even as a tourist. People cannot enter the shop if they are wearing shorts, short skirts and dresses, swimwear, ripped jeans and just dirty clothes.
