The biggest tropical rainforest on Earth is the Amazon rainforest. It is located in South America. Also, there are rainforests in Central America, the Congo, India and Australia.

Tropical rainforests have some of the biggest rivers on Earth like the Congo River in Africa, the Mekong River in Asia or the Amazon River in South America. Rainforests are amazing!
