

Some verbs just add -ed.

wash - washed

pick - picked

If the verb ends in a consonant and a 'y', the 'y' becomes an 'i' before you add -ed.

dry - dried

play - played

cry - cried

enjoy - enjoyed

If a verb already ends in the letter 'e', remove the 'e' and add -ed.

save - saved

like - liked

If a verb ends with one vowel and one consonant, double the consonant before adding -ed.

clap - clapped

fix - fixed

knit - knitted

mix - mixed

Write down the new form of that word using the -ed suffix. Be careful, as sometimes the new - ed suffix might need an extra consonant. Good luck!
