5. PRESENT PERFECT

1. BASIC FORM: / +

Example: I **have seen** John this morning

We **have** to him today (talk)

She **hasn't** me an email (send)

..... they an argument (have)

2. Ever / never

Examples:

..... you ever climbed a mountain?

..... they ever insects? (eat)

..... he on a camel? (ride)

I never to Africa (travel)

She never a serious problem (have)

It anyone (bite)

3. Just

Examples:

She at the airport

They an argument

4. Still haven't

Examples:

She me an email

They an argument

5. Already

Examples:

She home

We breakfast

6. Yet?

Examples:

..... he?

..... you the news? (hear)

7. Not yet

Examples:

She me an email.....

They an argument

2. PAST SIMPLE

1. BASIC FORM:

Examples

I to him yesterday

I to him yesterday

Did to him yesterday?

3. PAST SIMPLE

1. Used when the action is finished

I lived in London for three years

2. Time is usually specified

I visited Berlin last year

3. The period of time is finished

She arrived last week

4. Adverbs:

When

During

Last...

Ago

Once, twice...

Then

In the past,...

PRESENT PERFECT

1. Used when the action is not finished

I have lived in London for two years

2. Time is usually unspecified

I have visited Prague many times

3. The period of time is not finished

She arrived this week

4. Adverbs:

How long?

Lately

Since

Ever

In the last ...weeks

All my life

Today / This month

So far

Recently

For

Yet

Just

In the past ... weeks

5. BOTH / NEITHER / NONE

BOTH (2 elements)

Examples: They were both late
 of them left

NEITHER (2 elements)

Examples: Neither of us was late
 them left

NONE (more than two elements)
