

## A lot of – a little – a few

A lot of = molto – molti (singolare e plurale)

A little = poco, un po' di (solo singolare)

A few = pochi, alcuni (solo plurale)

### Examples:

Jack eats a lot of chocolate and a lot of biscuits.

I drink a little milk every morning.

I have a few friends in England.

## Select A LOT OF – A LITTLE – A FEW.

Sometimes more than just one option is possible.

1. There's coffee in the cup.
2. There are flowers in my garden.
3. We've got books in our bookcase.
4. There are files on my desktop.
5. Don't drink Fanta! It's not healthy.
6. There are people on the bus. It's full!
7. I'd like just ice-cream, not too much.
8. There's homework for tomorrow!

9. I've only got pens but you can have one.
10. There's sugar but it's OK to make a cake.
