

Preposition of time IN – ON – AT(Preposições de tempo in- on -at)

AT

A preposição **AT** deve ser usada:

com horas e horários: *at six o'clock, at midday*

com noite: *at night*

com algumas datas: *at Christmas, at Easter,*

mas ON Christmas Day (pois com dias, tem que usar ON).

ON

A preposição **ON** deve ser usada:

- **com dias e datas:** *on Monday, on December 6th*
- **com fim-de-semana:** *on the weekend*
- **na expressão "na hora":** *on time*

IN

A preposição **IN** deve ser usada:

.

com os períodos do dia: *in the morning / afternoon / evening*,

mas use **AT** *night*

- com as estações do ano: *in the spring, in the fall*
- com as semanas, meses, anos e séculos: *in the second week of February, in April, in* na expressão "em tempo": *in time*, e "just in time": *bem na hora*.
