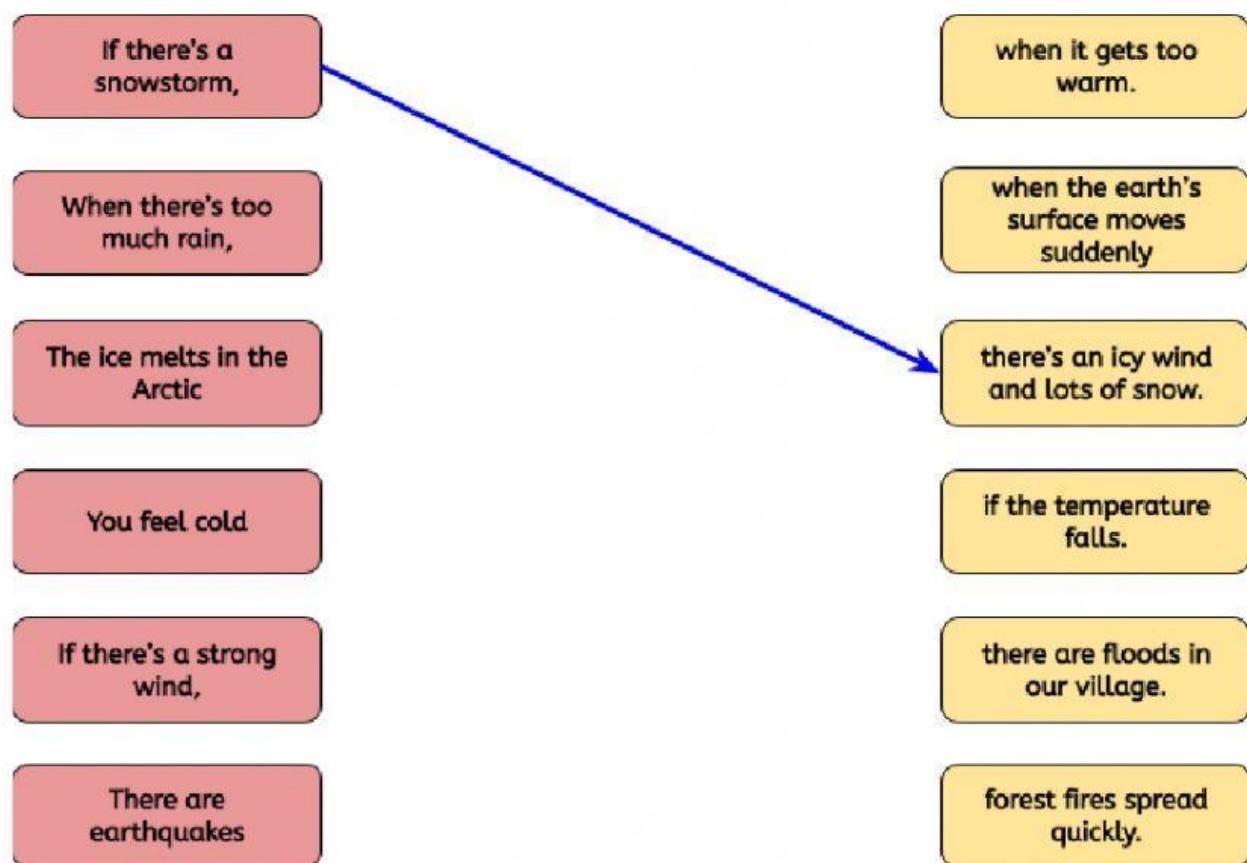


## Let's practice zero conditional!
