Ancient Maya civilisations played a ball game called *pitz*. Pitz is the first sport known in human history. Researchers have found several ball courts in many countries.

Much like football, the players couldn't touch the ball with their hands. The goal was to bounce the ball through stone hoops on the sides of the court. The ball was very heavy, so players wore a lot of padding for protection.
