RULES

TRANSITION

The spelling bee is conducted in 4 rounds.

- o Round 1: Picture reading category 1
- o Round 2: Picture reading category 2
- o Round 3: Picture reading category 3
- o Round 4: Phonics

Contestants have five seconds to think before naming the picture.

Contestants must name the pictures that the judges show them.

Each contestant remaining shall name one picture at random per round according to the category.

If a contestant does not say anything or gives a wrong answer, he or she will drop out the contest.

If no contestant reads a picture correctly during the round, all contestants remain in the competition.

If only one contestant reads a picture correctly during the round, that contestant will be the winner

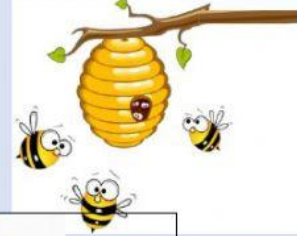
If more than one contestant gets to the round 4, the judges will show them a letter and contestants must say the name of the letter, the pronunciation and the name of an animal starting with that letter. The winner will be the contestant who pronounces better.

No help allowed (paper, cellphone, classmates). If a contestant gets any help, he or she will be expelled.

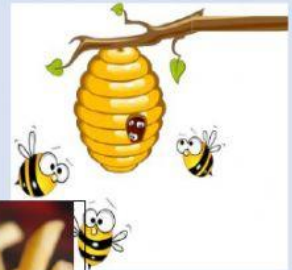

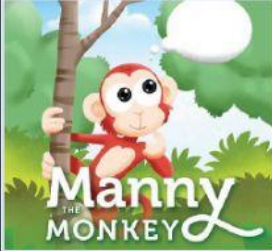
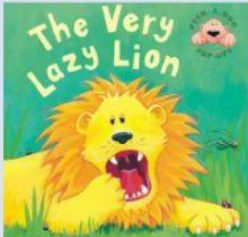
