PENANG: In the 2004 tsunami, when S. Thulaasi had only been 22 days old, she was swept out to sea. With the second wave, she then floated back to shore, still asleep on her mattress. When her father, Suppiah recalled the heart-stopping moment, he says he first saw two waves frothing like soap water in the distance. About 10 minutes later, he saw a large wave in the distance. In seconds, it got closer and looked like a towering wall of water. He shouted for everyone to run but the tsunami hit before many tourists could even get up.
