



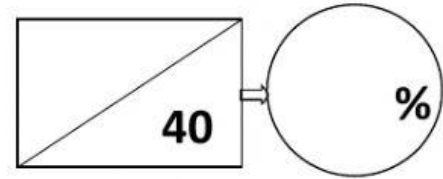

A hurricane is a phenomenon where a storm forms over very warm water in the ocean. The warm water heats up the air and the air rises rapidly into the atmosphere.
