

# PRONOUNS

We use a pronoun to identify who is the subject in a sentence.

**I, you\*, he, she, it, we, they**

**\*YOU can be used for singular or plural (second person)**

But not always we have pronouns in the sentences so we have to think about a replacement to work correctly our sentences:

**Example: Camila = she Daniel = he Camila and Daniel = they Camila and I = we  
Daniel and you = you**

Remember that the pronoun **IT** is used for singular (1 animal, 1 thing)

**Example: Horse = it Basket = it**

But when we need the plural pronoun for **animals and objects** we use **THEY**

**Example: The cats = they The books = they**

It means that the pronoun **THEY** can be used for ANIMALS, THINGS and of course PEOPLE.
