本單元將帶領讀者有效地學習閱讀技巧，本次要練習的閱讀技巧為「理解新聞標題隱含的意思 (Understanding Implicit Meanings of Newspaper Headlines)」。新聞標題不易理解，有時只是因為讀者對於陳述的主題不夠了解，加上新聞標題為了簡短，多半不會使用完整句，因此衍生出專有的字彙與用法，如：新聞標題中的冠詞和所有格代名詞通常會省略、動詞時態會改變或簡化、其他資訊通常不包含在標題裡等。接下來，讓我們一起按照步驟，一步一步將此技巧變成帶得走的能力吧！
