

Example of sentences in Spanish:

Remember that for the second part of your assessment (picture dictionary) you have to write five sentences as follows:

1. **Five sentences** in Spanish using some of the words that appear in your dictionary. You should use verbs, adjectives, nouns and articles to write your sentences. Do not forget the concordance between these elements.

Look at these examples and follow the structure to write them

1. Me gustan las manzanas dulces I like the sweet apples

Me gustan => VERB
las => ARTICLE (DEFINITE)
manzanas => NOUN
dulces => ADJECTIVE

2. Lucy come unas frutas acidas

Lucy eats some acid fruits

Lucy => NAME
Come => VERB
Unas => ARTICLE (INDEFINITE)
Frutas => NOUN
Acidas => ADJECTIVE
