GRAMMAR CLUE

Remember: to talk about **FUTURE** time we use the word **WILL**

- **Affirmative:** Subject + will + the verb + the rest of the sentence
People will go to the moon in the future.
- **Negative:** Subject + won't + the verb/action + the rest of the sentence
People won't go to the library in the future.
- **Questions:** → Will + there be + the subject + the rest of the sentence?
Will there be ice rinks in the future? – Answers: Yes, there will/ No, there won't
→ Will + the subject + the verb/action + the rest of the sentence?
Will people fly in the future? – Answers: Yes, they will/ No, they won't

REMEMBER

When we use WILL, the verb goes without TO

- People **WILL FLY** in the future.
- People ~~will TO~~ fly in the future.
