GRAMMAR CLUE

Remember: to talk about FUTURE time we use the word WILL

- Affirmative: Subject + will + the verb + the rest of the sentence

 People will go to the moon in the future.
- Negative: Subject + won't + the verb/action + the rest of the sentence
 People won't go to the library in the future.
- Questions: Will + there be + the subject + the rest of the sentence?

 Will there be ice rinks in the future? Answers: Yes, there will/ No, there won't

Will + the subject + the verb/action + the rest of the sentence?
Will people fly in the future? – Answers: Yes, they will/ No, they won't

- People WILL FLY in the future.
- People will TO fly in the future.
