-y, e.g. sun – *sunny*
-ate, e.g. passion – *passionate*;
-able / -ible, e.g. fashion – *fashionable*;
-ful, e.g. use – *useful*.
-ful to -less, e.g. *useful* – *useless*,
hopeful – *hopeless*.

-ence often make the adjective
with -ent, e.g. *violence* – *violent*.
