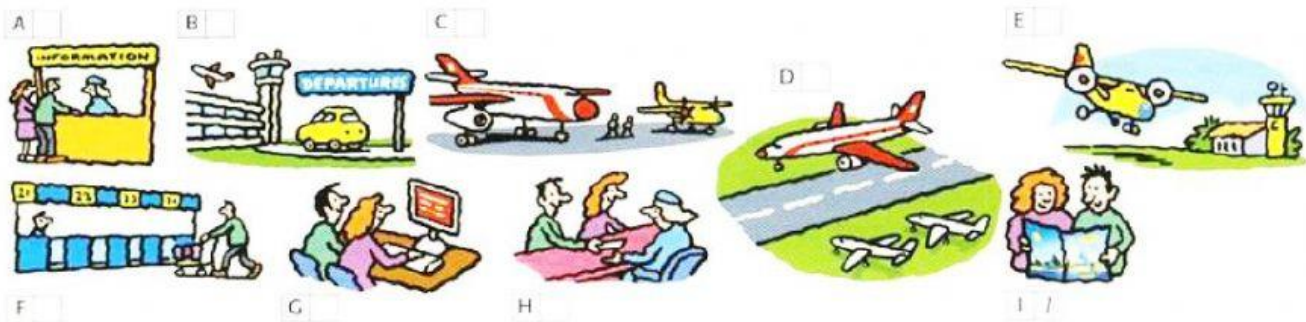
She looked at our tickets. 'The next flight? This is the end of your journey. Where **did you want** to go?'
