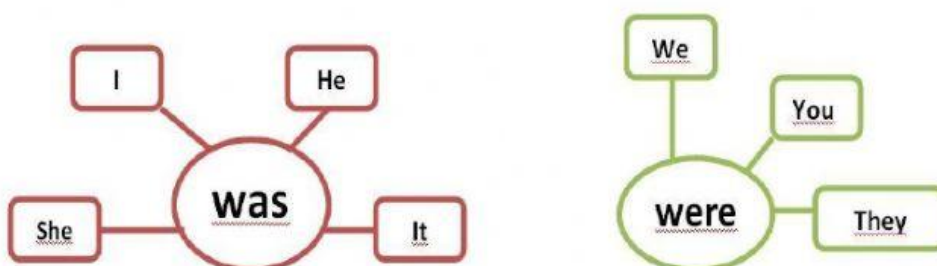


PAST CONTINUOUS

What it is:

Past continuous or past progressive is a verbal tense which indicates the action progression in a determinate moment in the past. It is conformed by the past of verb To Be (WAS or WERE) and gerund of main verb (ING).

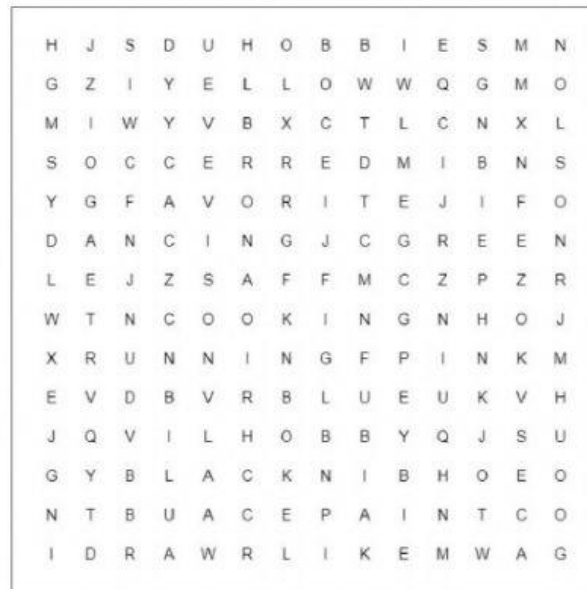
