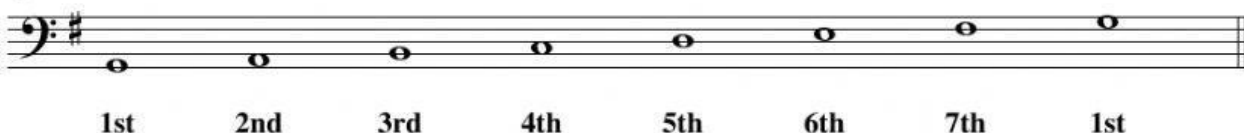


Scale Degrees

Now it's time to look at how we use scale degrees to identify notes in a song. Lets examine the song below:



If we look at the song, the first thing we should determine is the key before identifying its scale degrees.



Using the key signature, we can determine that the song is in the key of G Major. We can now use the scale degrees from the G major scale to identify the scale degrees within the song.



Now that we have established the key of the song, we can now move towards labelling the scale degrees of the song. The first note of the song is **D**. If we compare it to the *G major scale* previously listed, we can see that D is the **5th** scale degree in the key of G. Therefore, the first note of the song (**D**) is the 5th scale degree.

Take note: Measure 3 and 5 both have the note B but they are in different positions. This doesn't change the scale degree.

Now let's try one.
