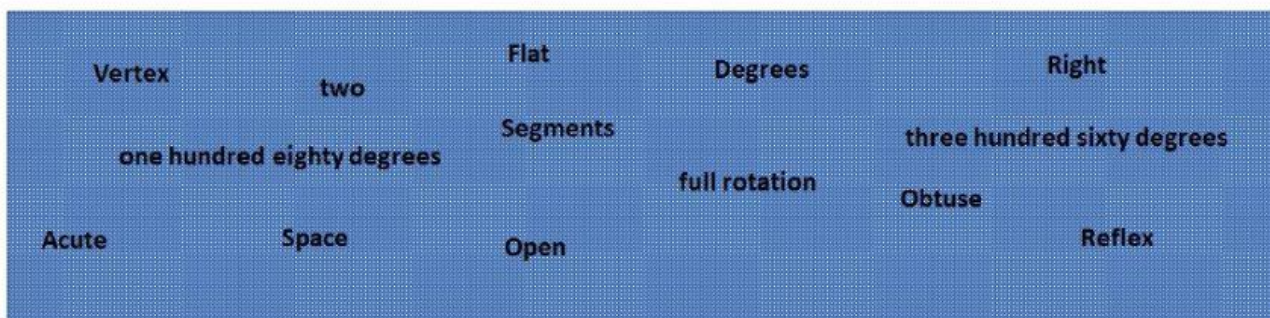
\_\_\_\_\_ angles are those angles that measure more than ninety degrees ( $> 90^\circ$ ) but less than one hundred eighty degrees ( $< 180^\circ$ ).

\_\_\_\_\_ angles are those angles that measure exactly \_\_\_\_\_ ( $= 180^\circ$ ).

\_\_\_\_\_ angles measure more than one hundred eighty degrees ( $> 180^\circ$ ) and less than \_\_\_\_\_ ( $< 360^\circ$ ).

A \_\_\_\_\_ angle measures exactly three hundred sixty degrees ( $= 360^\circ$ ).
