



The map illustrates plans for two possible sites for a shopping centre in the city of Brandfield.

It can be seen that the two sites (S1, S2) under consideration are in the north west of the town (S1) and the south east (S2). Additionally, S1 is close to a residential area, while S2 is just next to an industrial zone.

The first possible site for the shopping mall, S1, is just south east of the city centre, above the railway line, running from the north west of the city to the south east. If it is built here, it will be close to a large residential area, providing easy access for those living there and in the city centre. It will also be close to the river, which runs through the town.

While, The site in the south east (S2) is again close to the railway line and the road to the city centre, it is near an industrial estate rather than housing. As for the main road that runs through the city, it is close to both sites, thus providing good road access to either location. Finally, a large golf course and park in the town prevents this area from being available as a site.
