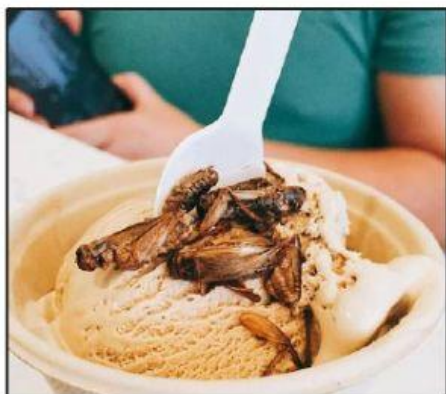

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Study/ Present perfect (Past participle of verbs)

What is the Past Participle?

The past participle of a verb is one of two past forms. As an English student, you've probably studied some irregular verbs, seen in a list consisting of three words: the infinitive, the simple past, and the past participle.

Infinitive	Past simple	Past participle
Be	Was / Were	Been

As you can see, the third form of the verb, usually written on the right, is the past participle.

English verbs can be separated into two categories – regular verbs and irregular verbs. Regular verbs follow a simple pattern in which both the past simple and the past participle form of the verb are created by adding -ed.

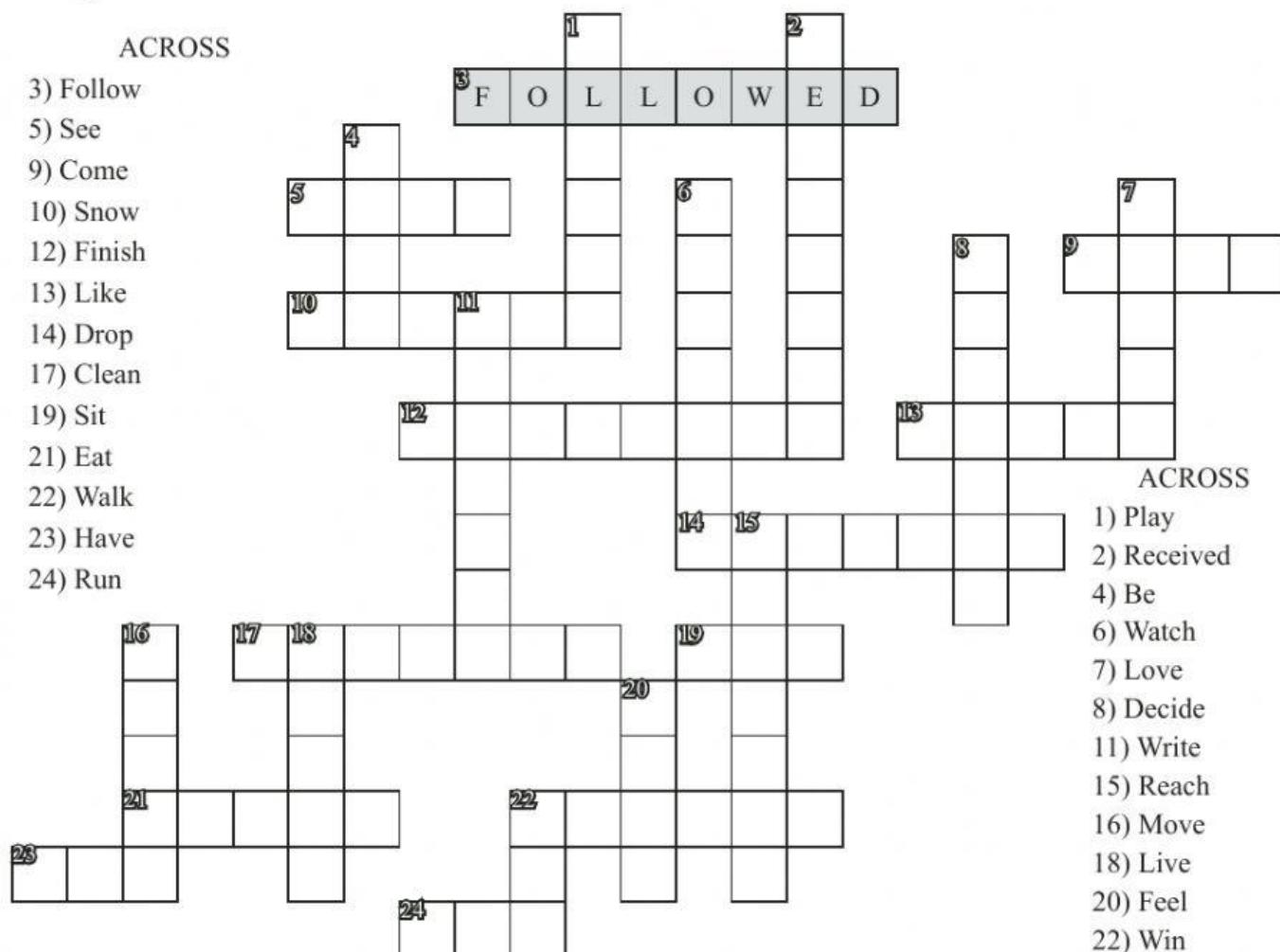
So creating past participle from regular verbs is quite easy. Unfortunately there are also irregular verbs in English which don't follow a fixed pattern. In this case you simply need to learn them. The best way to do this is to learn them gradually as part of a structured course.

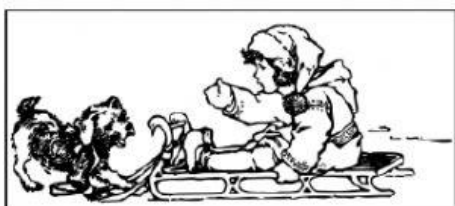
