

PASADO SIMPLE Y PASADO CONTINUO.

PASADO SIMPLE -> auxiliar **DID**. El **pasado simple** se usa cuando hablamos que una acción quedó completamente en el pasado, terminó.
Verbos: Regulares: con finalidad -ed. Paint - painted (pintar - pintó).
Irregulares: 2da fila de la lista de verbos. Go - went (ir - fue).

Afirmativo:

SUJETO + VERBO • I went to the school - Yo fui al colegio.
• He arrived last week - El llegó la semana pasada.

Negativo:

SUJETO + DID NOT (didn't) + VERBO EN INFINITIVO

- I didn't go to the school - Yo no fui al colegio.
- He didn't arrive last week - El no llegó la semana pasada.

Interrogativo:

DID + SUJETO + VERBO EN INFINITIVO

- Did you go to the school? - Fuiste vos al colegio?
- Did he arrive last week? - Llegó el la semana pasada?

PASADO CONTINUO -> auxiliares **WAS - WERE**.

El **pasado continuo** lo usamos cuando queremos contar que una acción está en desarrollo hasta que llegó otra y la cortó (la cortó el presente simple). O cuando queremos describir un entorno.

Auxiliar **WAS** y **WERE**. Y los verbos, **SIEMPRE** van con **ing** al final.

Afirmativo:

SUJETO + WAS / WERE + VERBO -ING

- I was going to the school - yo estaba yendo al colegio.
- You were singing rock and roll - Ustedes estaban cantando rock and roll.

Negativo:

SUJETO + WAS / WERE + NOT + VERBO -ING

- I was not going to the school - Yo no estaba yendo al colegio.
- You were not singing Rolling Stone - Ustedes no estaban cantando rock and roll.

Interrogativo:

WAS / WERE + SUJETO + VERBO -ING

- Was he going to the school? - Estaba él yendo al colegio?
- Were you singing rock and roll? - Estaban ustedes cantando rock and roll?
