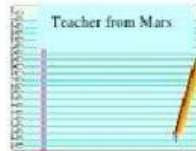

BE SURE TO:

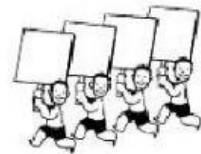
- ✓ Write a good title.

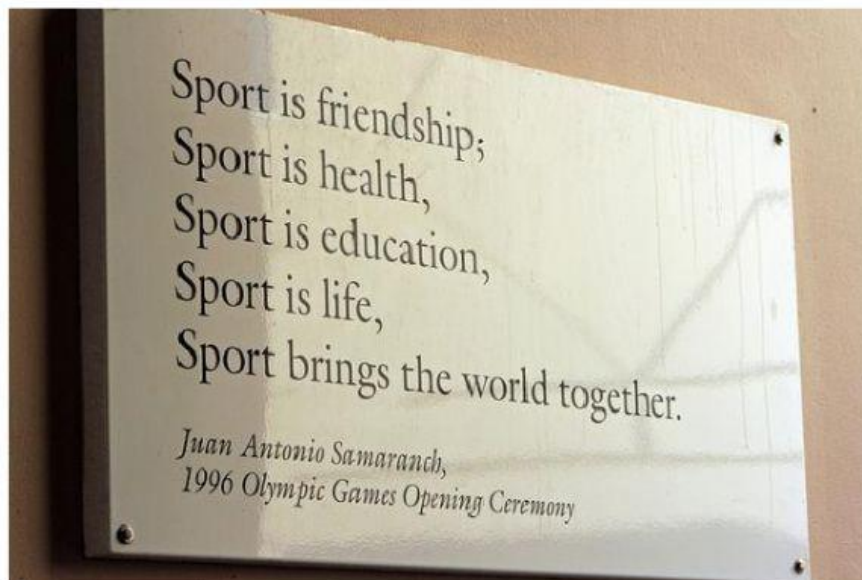
