The dates are different every year because of a National Holiday. The Carnival takes place seven weeks before a National Holiday. Thousands of tourists come to Rio for the Carnival.

There is a Samba Parade every night of the festival. It takes place in a special stadium called the Sambadromo in front of about 100,000 spectators. The dancers wear amazing costumes and do a special Brazilian dance called the samba. The parade starts at seven o'clock in the evening and finishes the next morning at around nine o'clock.

There are carnival balls every night of the festival. These often take place at large hotels and tickets are usually expensive. Guests wear elegant, formal clothes. They eat, drink and dance with bands from 11:00 p.m. until the morning. Nobody sleeps during the Carnival!
