Some animals are pets and live in people's houses. Dogs, cats, and goldfish are pets.

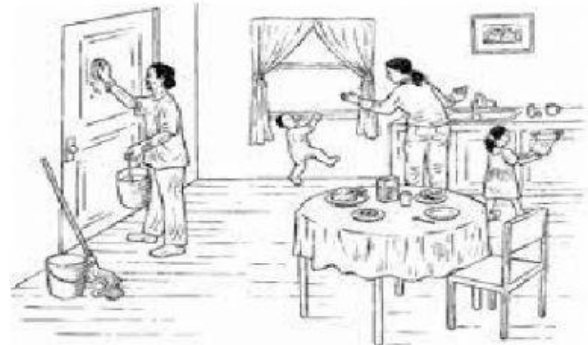

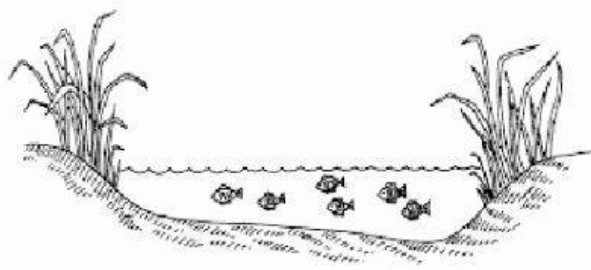
