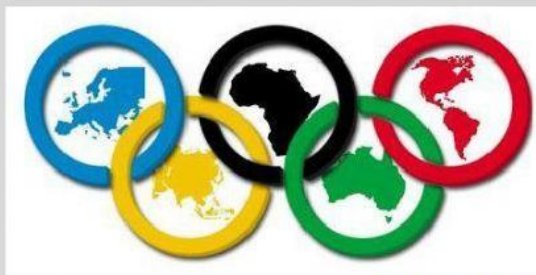

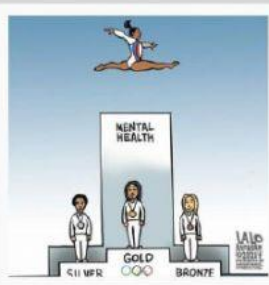

Argentina competed at the **2020 Summer Olympics** in **Tokyo**. Originally scheduled to take place from 24 July to 9 August 2020, the Games were postponed to 23 July to 8 August 2021, because of the **COVID-19 pandemic**.^[a] Since the nation's official debut in **1900**, Argentine athletes have competed in every edition of the Summer Olympic Games, except the **1904 Summer Olympics** in St. Louis, the **1912 Summer Olympics** in Stockholm, and the **1980 Summer Olympics** in Moscow because of their support for the **United States-led boycott**.
