### Rule 1: Add -ed

I **watched** movie last night.  
I **walked** to school today.  
Mum **cooked** a delicious meal yesterday.

### Rule 2: Add -d

I **liked** my previous school.  
I **baked** my own birthday cake..  
He **saved** the kitten not long ago..

### Rule 3: Add -ied if verb ends with consonant and -y

**cry** → She **fried** some noodles for me.  
**fry** → I **cried** when my puppy died.

### Rule 4: Add double consonant and -ed if verb ends with single vowel and single consonant

I **clapped** my hands.  
I **jogged** for 5 miles yesterday.
