ALTHOUGH/EVEN THOUGH

+ SUBJECT + VERB
NO COMMA AFTER IT

Although/Even though we played well, we lost.

We played well, **although/even though** we lost.

HOWEVER

(;)/(.) + **HOWEVER**
+ COMMA (,)

We played well. **However**, we lost.

I eat better. **However**, I'm keep gaining weight.

IN SPITE OF/DESPITE

+ NOUN / -ING

We went out **in spite of/despite** the rain.

+ **THE FACT THAT**
+ SUBJECT + VERB

We went out **in spite of/despite** the fact that it was raining.
