- \* After nouns, (His ambition to be rich has destroyed his family)
- \* After WH question words, (I haven't decided where to go this summer)
- \* With the structures TOO and ENOUGH, (It is too heavy to lift) (I am strong enough to lift it)
- \* With the structures "It + to be + adjective + of + object pronouns" (It was kind of you to help me)
